

#### **Career Outcomes**



Automotive apprenticeships are generally grouped into either Heavy Vehicle or Light Vehicle Mechanic with a range of specialisation options.



Heavy Vehicle Mechanics work on large mobile machinery such as mining vehicles, commercial trucks, agricultural or earthmoving equipment. Qualified heavy vehicle mechanics may find employment with large logistics companies, in the mining sector, in regional locations for agriculture, and with government departments.



Light Vehicle Mechanics generally work on recreational vehicles in a workshop setting. Automotive Mechanics may specialise as Brake Mechanics, Automotive Air-conditioning Mechanics or as Breakdown Service Officers. With advancements in automotive technology, there are now more electronic controls and computers fitted to vehicles, so mechanics are becoming more specialised.


